



CABERNET SAUVIGNON-MERLOT

Varietal: 50% Cabernet Sauvignon – 50 % Merlot

VINEYARD:

Both grapes are from vineyards located in Montecaseros, San Martín. They are characterized by their sandy and deep soils, with traditional irrigation. The Cabernet gives a yield of 12 thousand kg per ha, while the Merlot gives 10 ml kg / ha. Both vineyards date from more than 40 years ago.

HARVEST:

2020. Manual harvest in box of 20 kg, during the first and second week of April.

AGING:

For 6 months, 30% of the wine rests in American oak barrels. The remaining 70% rests in stainless steel tanks in contact with French oak staves.

TASTING:

Ruby red wine with violet sparkles.

On the nose it is highlighted by its opulence in red fruits and black pepper.

In the mouth they are marked tannins, giving a concentrated wine, robust and rich fruit. The presence of vanilla, coconut and tobacco stands out. Long finish and persistent aftertaste.

Alcohol: 13,60 % v/v
