Capernet Sauvignon

Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon 100%

Vineyard:

Montecaseros, San Martín. Warm, sandy soils in eastern Mendoza. Traditionally irrigated, the vines are 10 years old, yielding 10,000 kilos per hectare.

Harvest:

2023. Manually harvested in 20-kilo boxes during the third week of April.

Aging:

30% of the wine is aged for 12 months in American oak barrels. The remaining 70% is aged in stainless steel tanks in contact with strongly toasted French oak staves.

Tasting:

Appearance: This wine is bright and clean, ruby red.

On the nose, the varietal displays all its typical character, imparting aromas of black fruits, green pepper, and coffee.

On the palate, it has a marked presence and good volume, with strong tannins and balanced acidity. Long aftertaste.

Aging potential: 6 years

Alcohol: 13.80% v/v
